

#### *For a single photo:*

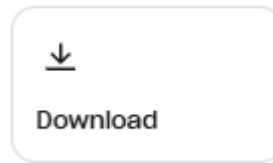
- A. Click on a photo to see the full-size image



- B. Click on the button on the top right corner of the page:

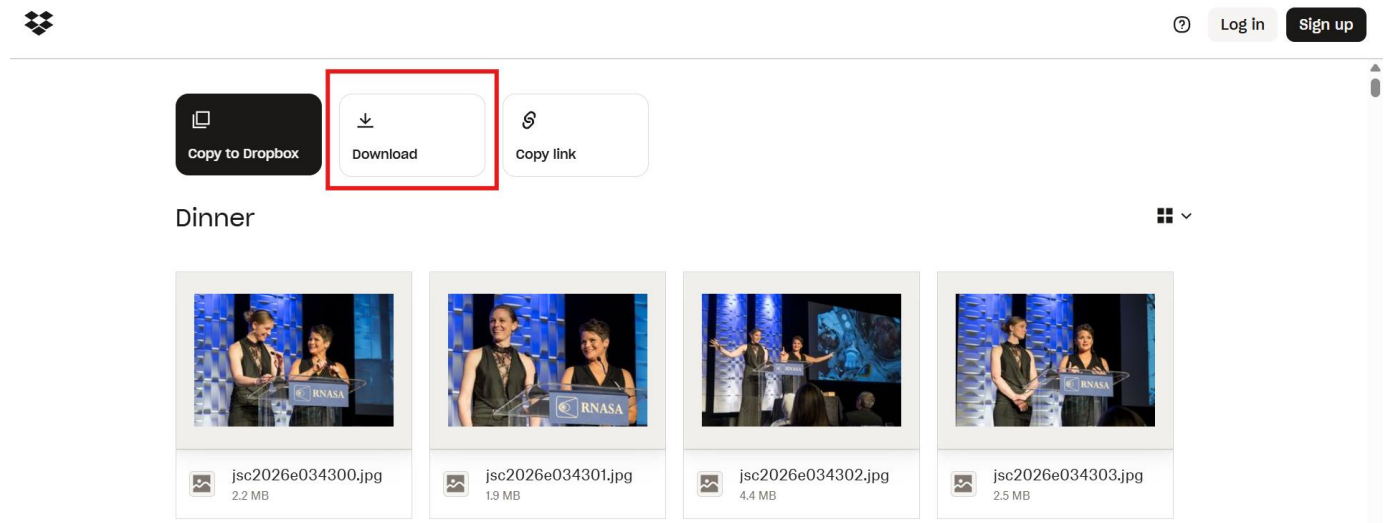
